Tapestry – Blog Style!


Every day the staff will take a selection of photos and write a small amount on what the children have done during the day.

We have created 'a child' called 'Monday Ducks', 'Monday Ducklings', 'Tuesday Ducks' etc.

You will have been assigned to the relevant days that your child attends. E.g. If your child is booked in on Mon, Thur and Fri, then you will have the equivalent Mon, Thur, Fri, days assigned to you as a parent on Tapestry. You will receive notifications dependant on the settings you created when you originally logged in, you can adjust these yourself.

This will allow you to look at what your child has done from the comfort of your home and alongside your child. We would welcome your feedback on this as it's rolled out to the entire setting.

Your child will still have their usual observations done and these will be put on your child's account as normal.
